Frequently Asked Questions

1. When does Little Steps start?

The program will run from September 8, 2026 to June 11, 2027.

2. What are the class sizes in Little Steps?

Being a licensed preschool, we cap our classes at 12 students.

3. How old does my child have to be to attend?

For the 3 year old program, children must turn 3 by December 31, 2026. For the 4 year old program, children must turn 4 by December 31, 2026.

4. Does my child have to be potty trained to attend?

Yes, children must be potty trained to attend. We understand that accidents do happen and so we ask that children are sent with an extra set of clean clothes just in case.

5. What will my child learn?

At Little Steps, we believe that the best learning happens through play, exploration, and imagination! As a licensed preschool for children ages 3-5, we offer a vibrant, play-based program that nurtures social, emotional, and cognitive development in a fun and engaging way.

We proudly follow Alberta's Flight Curriculum, a play-based, child-led approach that supports young learners in developing independence, creativity, and problem-solving skills. Our program is guided by the interests of our students, meaning every day is filled with exciting new adventures! With a wide variety of materials and resources at their fingertips, children are free to create, explore, and discover in a dynamic, hands-on environment that fuels their curiosity and growth.

We also ensure a smooth transition to Kindergarten by aligning with our school's "Get Ready for School" curriculum—giving our Little Steps students a head start on key early learning skills while still embracing the joy of play.

6. What are the yearly fees for Little Steps?

Little Steps fees have been reduced thanks to our participation in the Affordability Grant.

7. Are there multi-disciplinary supports available in Little Steps?

Speech-Language and Occupational Therapy is available for students who qualify under the PUF requirements.

8. What supplies should I send with my Little Step student?

Your child only needs a backpack, lunch-kit with a snack, water bottle, and indoor shoes. Students will have a locker to store all their items in.

9. How will I know what to do on the first day of Little Steps?

At the end of August, we send out welcome packages to all our Little Step students. In this package, you will find all the required information you need such as the Little Steps handbook, year calendar, and first day instructions!

10. Does Little Steps interact with CKCS?

Yes! We love seeing the littlest members of our school community! Little Steps not only has access to school facilities such as the gym and the library, but they are also invited to participate in special school events throughout the year!

11. When does Little Steps close?

Little Steps runs on the same calendar schedule as CKCS. So if CKCS is closed for a holiday or PD day, then Little Steps is closed as well.

12. Are there snow days in Little Steps?

During school snow days, Little Steps remains open for those that can safely arrive.
